DISCIPLINARY DECISION ON SUNSET FC FOR MISCONDUCT

SUMMARY OF FACTS AND CHARGES SUNSET FC

Reference to the Match Officials Reports, the Charge Sheet in respect of Volta Regional Division Two League match to be played at Sir Noble Park between Sunset FC and Golden Stars FC on 25th January, 2026. The Secretary of the Disciplinary Committee of the RFA charged **Sunset FC** (hereinafter referred to as “**The Respondent**”) on the 17th February, 2026 for misconduct and the case was referred to the Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter referred to as “**The Committee**”). **Sunset FC** was charged for misconduct on the following counts;

1. That **Sunset FC** breached Article 16(1) of the GFA Disciplinary Code, 2019
2. That **Sunset FC**, during Volta Regional Division Two League match played at Sir Noble Park between Sunset FC and Golden Stars FC, Sunset FC on the 25th January, 2026 breached provisions of the GFA Disciplinary Code, 2019 for misconduct. An action which amounts to unsporting behaviour and misconduct.
3. That **Sunset FC** breached Article 34(1)(b) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations

4. **That Sunset FC** on 25th January, 2026, during the Volta Regional Division Two League Match played at Sir Noble Park between the Respondent and Golden Stars FC the Respondent breached provisions of Article 34(1)(b) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations. The Respondent team officials Philip Dordzinu and Malike Dzado was alleged to have physically attacked the Centre Referee which rendered the continuity of the said match impossible. An action which amounts to unsporting behaviour and misconduct.

Sunset FC was given up to Thursday 19th February, 2026 to response to the charge

STATEMENT OF DEFENSE

Sunset FC pleaded **GUILTY** to all the charges

FINDINGS OF THE COMMITTEE AND GROUNDS OF DECISION

The Committee at its sittings makes the following findings

1. That in accordance with article 34(1)(b) of the GFA/Regional Football Association Leagues the Disciplinary Committee is satisfied with the evidence before it that conduct of Sunset FC amounts to a breach of the Regulations and shall accordingly apply the necessary the sanctions against Sunset FC.

2. That it must be noted that the situation caused by Sunset FC affects the image of the Division Two League and Ghana football.

3. That the misconduct of the said team officials Philip Kwaku Dordzinu and Melike Dzado led to the abrupt end of the said match


4. That Sunset Misconduct were unnecessary and served to undermine the integrity of the Volta Regional Division Two League.

5. That the Committee finds Sunset **guilty** of the charges.

DECISION

.This Committee, having satisfied itself that the evidence adduced before it supports the charges of misconduct against the club and hereby finds Sunset FC guilty of all the charges in accordance with Article 16(1) of the GFA Disciplinary Code (2019) and Article 34(1)(b) of the GFA Regional Football Association Leagues Regulations and therefore makes the following decisions;

1. That the Respondent Sunset FC is hereby fined GHC 1000.00 (ONE Thousand Ghana Cedis) to be paid to the RFA within fourteen (14) days upon receipt of this ruling.
2. That Sunset FC shall be liable to the consequential effect of Article 37 (1)(b) and 37 (8)(c) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations if the club fails to pay the fine imposed on the club in decision One (1) above within the period specified in decision One above.
3. That the said team officials Philip Kwaku Dordzinu and Melike Dzado are warned to be of good behavior in subsequent matches, failing which a more severe punishment will be imposed.
4. That the temporal ban served on Sunset FC from playing their home matches away is hereby lifted by this ruling.
