IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION FOR STAY OF EXECUTION
BY KETA FOOTBALL CLUB
PENDING THE OUTCOME OF THE CLUB'S APPEAL AGAINST THE VOLTA RFA
DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE DECISION ON CASE NO. VRFA/DC/031/26

PROCEEDINGS

In accordance with Articles 35(15) and 36(2)(e) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations, the Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter refers to as “the Committee”) examined the application from Keta FC (hereinafter refers to as “**the Applicant**”).

SUMMARY OF THE FACTS

On Thursday, May 28th, 2026, Keta FC applied to this Committee for a grant of a Stay of Execution pending the outcome of the Appeal Case against the Committee’s ruling on case No. VRFA/DC/031/26.

FINDINGS AND GROUNDS OF THE DECISION

It is very clear that Keta FC is appreciative of Article 15(b) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations hence the Application to this Committee for the stay of execution.

The Applicant has also satisfied the requirement of Article 35(15)(e) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations, by the club’s payment of the requisite filing fee of One Hundred Ghana Cedis (GHC 100.00)

Article 35(15)(a) of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues states as follows:

“An appeal does not operate as a Stay of Execution or have a suspension effect except with regard to orders to pay a sum of money”.

It is required by law that an Applicant must show that if the stay of execution is not granted the club would suffer some irreparable damage should the appeal of the club become successful at the Appeal Committee.

The arguments advanced by the Applicant to this Committee to show why the appeal of the applicant would succeed have no sufficient grounds in the perspective of relevant provisions of the GFA Regional Football Associations Leagues Regulations to compel this Committee grant the Applicant the Stay of Execution of the Committee's decision in the case of Yingor FC vrs Keta FC of Case No. VRFA/DC/031/26

The Committee therefore finds that no reason was given by the Applicant and hence holds that Keta FC has not provided any grounds for the decision on the said case to be stayed.

DECISION

The Committee therefore, makes the following decisions:

1. That the Application for Stay of Execution by Keta FC is hereby dismissed.
2. That there is no order on cost.
